

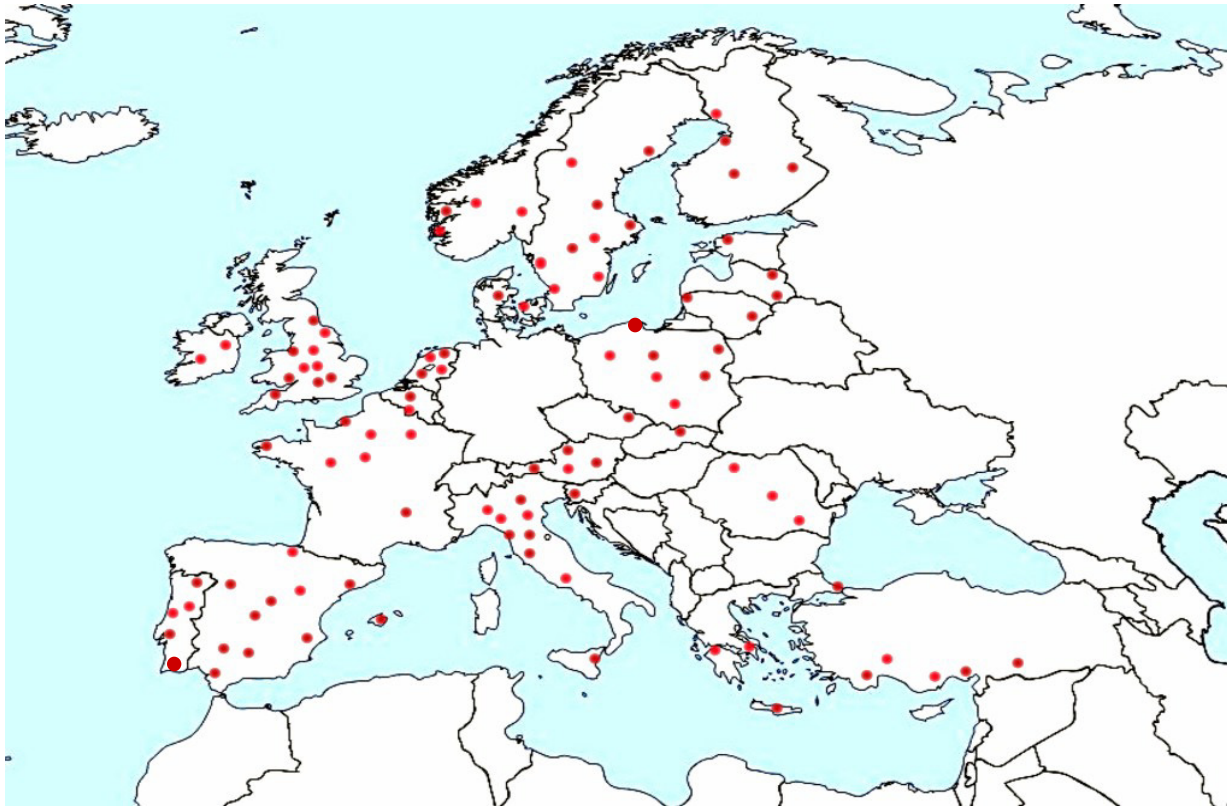

ERAMUS parter universities

- no tuition fee
- monthly grant of approx. 160 Euro/month
- validation of credit points
- ERASMUS contacts (local)
- no language test required

Where to go outside Europe?

approx. 35 cooperations, e.g. in:

- USA & Canada
- Australia
- South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda
- Argentina, Chile, Guatemala
- China, Japan, India
- Russia

Study in a Non-EU country

- no tuition or reduced tuition fees
- application at *International Student Office (ISO)* or own application at foreign university

When to go?

- 3rd or 5th semester
- which semester is recommended (by your faculty)?
- check semester dates of the university abroad
- deadline: 1st Mar. for winter term
31st Oct. for summer term

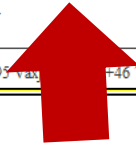
